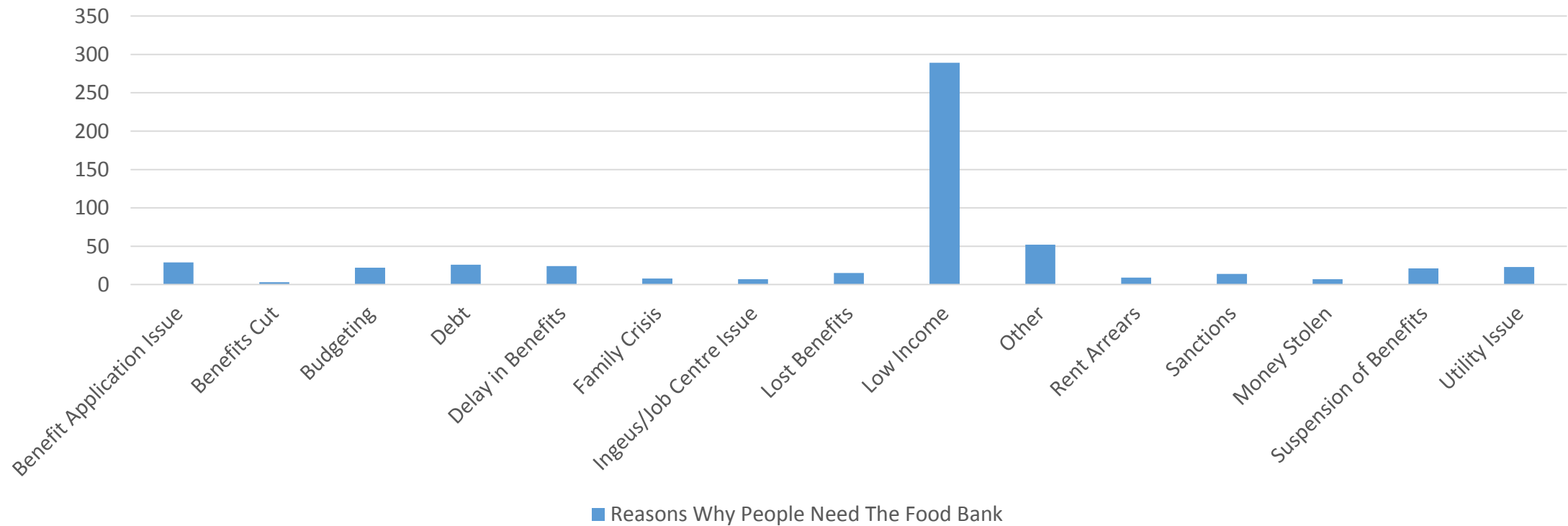
Bute Food-Bank

A Year On

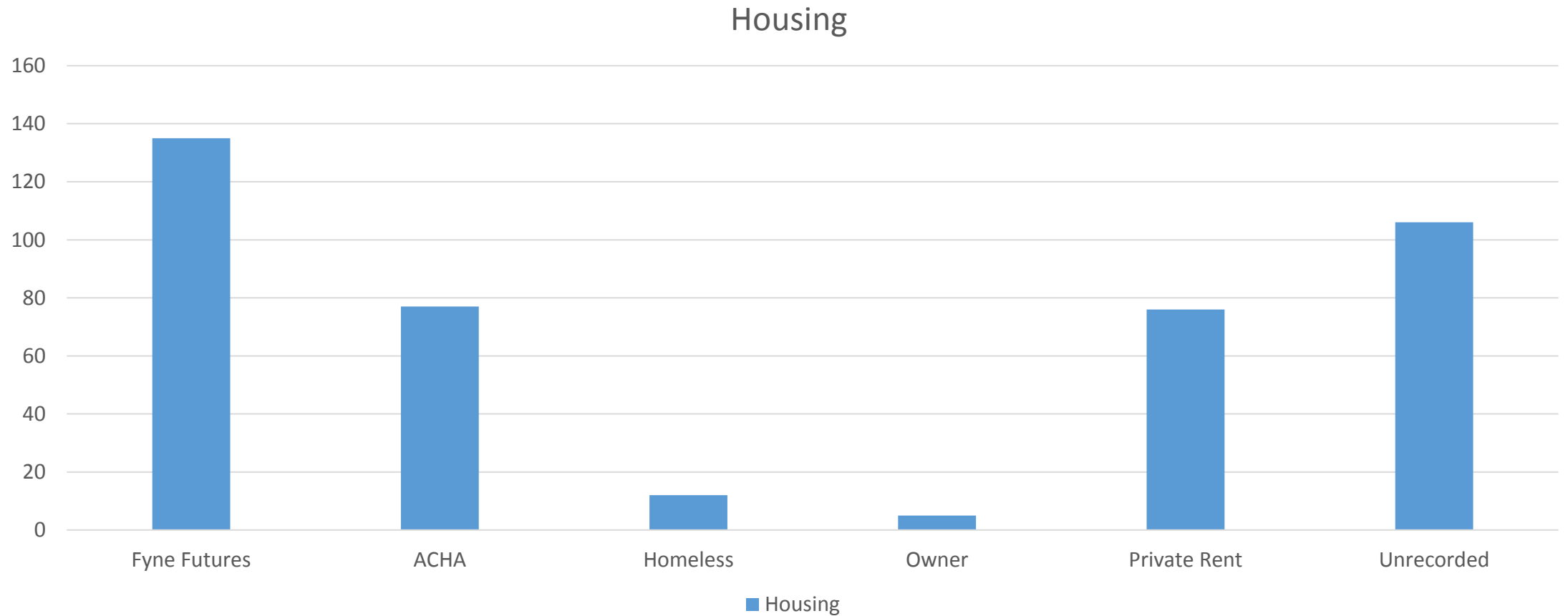
The Bute Food-Bank has been a resounding success on the Island of Bute. Supporting the most vulnerable in our community seven days a week. Bute Oasis has worked tirelessly in providing almost all the food given out and thanks go to the members of the public who make their donations. The combined forces of the ADG, Bute Advice Centre and Bute Oasis has meant that 1236 daily allocations of food have been given out. What makes this Food Bank unique is the fact that alongside the necessary food, clients are given support and advice to deal with the underlying issues. Clients can access the Food Bank from Bute Advice Centre during their 4 day working week and the remaining days from Bute Oasis who are open 7 days per week. The following report will show the reasons given by clients who present with need and the support they are then given.

There were 412 referrals from January 2014 – January 2015 where 1236 daily allocations of food were disseminated through Bute Advice Centre and Bute Oasis.

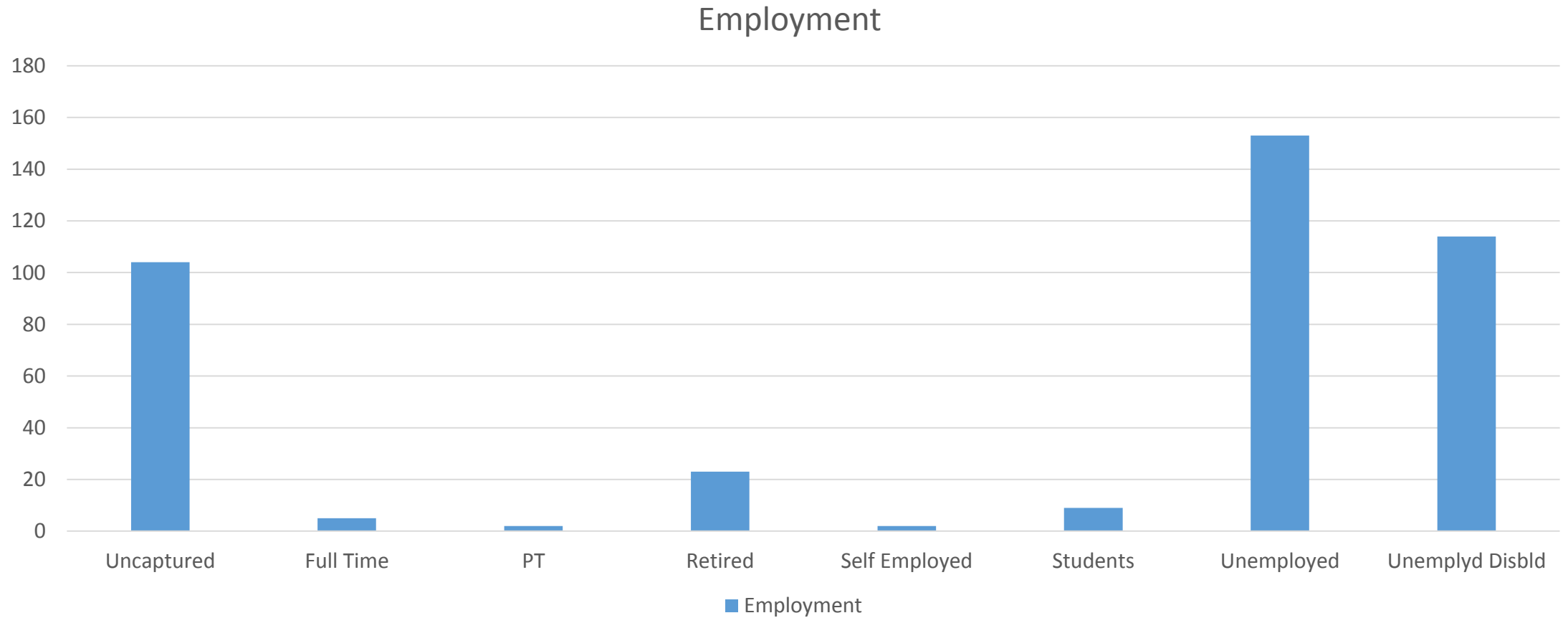
Reasons Why People Need The Food Bank
Individuals often choose more than 1 category



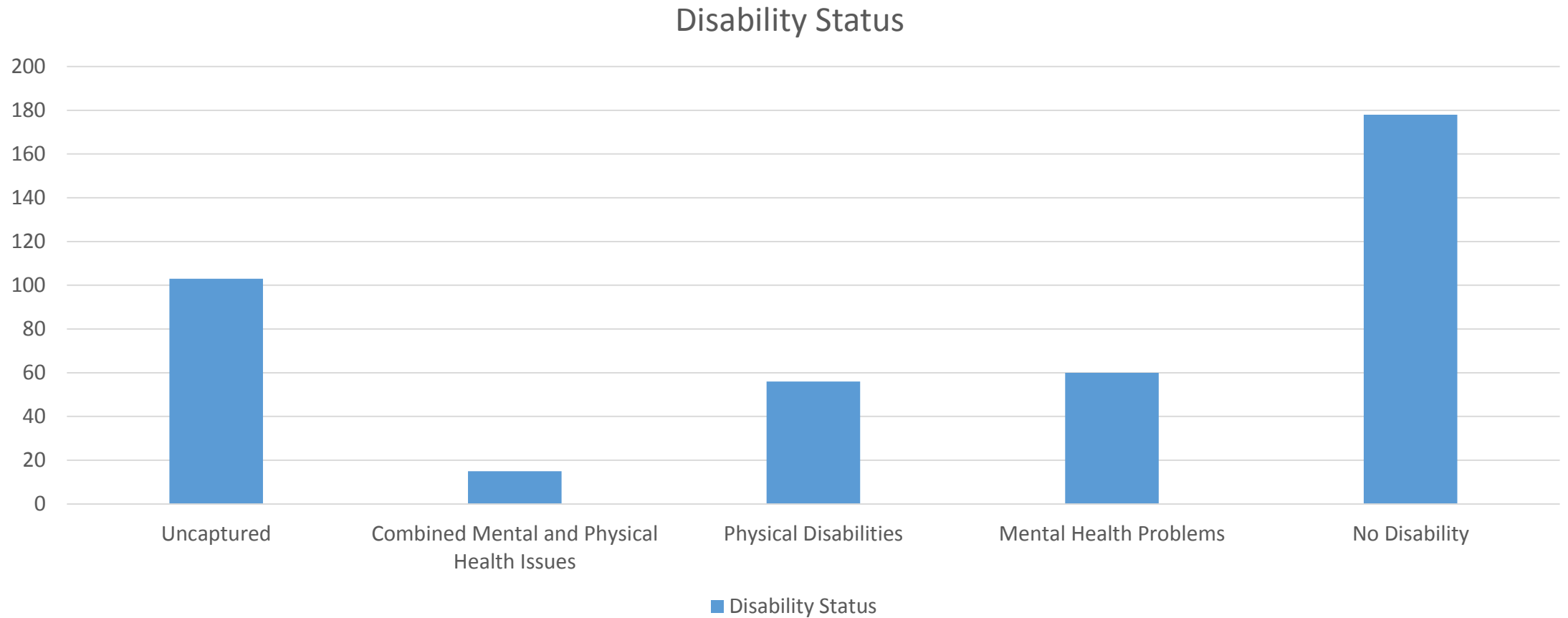
Housing Demographic Info of Food Bank Users
